This is a course for action and immersion - students will be out in the field every week practicing the art of night photography! From the very first session, students will dispel several of the technical myths surrounding night time photography and get immediately acquainted with a strong foundation in how the camera can best capture low-light images. When dusk descends and night begins, the world changes in front of the lens and grand, magical, potent worlds emerge.

This hands-on 2-day class is a logical next step for beginner photographers who understand the basic principles of exposure and want to go further. Participants will begin by reviewing camera controls before going on a shooting excursion where they will practice how key concepts come together in real world situations under the guidance of a knowledgeable instructor. The second day will be spent developing images using Adobe Photoshop Lightroom 3.
